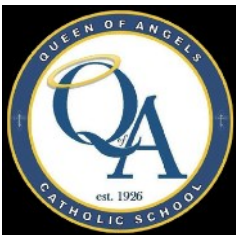

SUNDAY DEVOTIONS | A MEDITATION ON NEXT WEEK'S MASS READINGS

Oct. 13, 2019 | **28th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

First Reading—The focus of this reading is not so much Naaman's cure, but his confession of faith. Elisha's refusal of Naaman's gift in thanksgiving for the cure is also a confession of faith. It shows that those who serve the Lord are not in need of material gifts, because their life comes from the Lord God, and is true gift itself. [2 Kings 5:14-17]

Responsorial Psalm—"The Lord has revealed to the nations His saving power." [Psalm 98]

Second Reading—Paul continues to write Timothy, urging him to remember the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the same Gospel for which Paul is enduring suffering and imprisonment. Chains never limit the Gospel. The freedom of God's Word allows Paul to bear with his own suffering for the sake of those whom God chooses. [2 Timothy 2:8-13]

Gospel—Here we have the story of the cleansing of the ten lepers. Jesus encounters the lepers as He travels from Samaria and Galilee, coming near the end of His journey to Jerusalem.

As in the first reading with Naaman's cure, we see that religious or ethnic background pose no obstacles to salvation for the Samaritan leper.

Jesus' command concluding this passage sends the healed Samaritan on his way knowing that his faith brings him salvation's wholeness. Like Naaman, he goes forward in life differently now: a grateful and saved foreigner who speaks of new life. [Luke 17:11-19]
