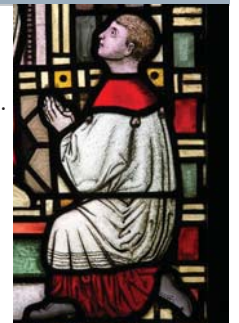

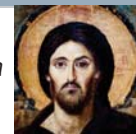

SUNDAY DEVOTIONS | A MEDITATION ON NEXT WEEK'S MASS READINGS

Oct. 20, 2019 | **29th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

First Reading—Wielding the staff he previously used to split the Red Sea and to call its destructive waters back down upon Pharaoh's army, Moses intercedes for his people as they engage in battle against the Amalekites who are trying to deny the Israelites the land God promised them. [*Exodus 17:8-13*]

Responsorial Psalm—"Our help is from the Lord, who made heaven and earth." [*Psalms 121*]

Second Reading—"All Scripture is inspired by God"—the divine inspiration of the Scriptures is why Paul tells Timothy they can be useful to him in all areas of his pastoral work. Formation in the Word of God makes a leader competent to carry out his or her call. No matter how untimely or irrelevant the Word might seem, Paul admonishes Timothy to persevere in the proclamation of the Word and to use it to help believers remain faithful. [*2 Timothy 3:14-4:2*]

Gospel—Persisting in prayers does not simply mean praying continuously. When the Son of Man comes, He will be looking for faith. The faith of a disciple contrasts with that of the Pharisees who sought the strict observance of legal works to showcase their faith. But the faith Jesus seeks is that which trusts in God's gracious love. [*Luke 18:1-8*]
