

### FIRST FRIDAY— St. Joseph

he devotion to the Sacred Heart is nothing more than an exercise of love toward our loving Savior. Therefore, the principal and spiritual object of this devotion, is the love with which the heart of Jesus is inflamed toward all. But St. Mary Margaret reports as Jesus spoke to her, "Behold the Heart" that has loved humanity and has spared nothing for them, even to consuming itself to give them pledges of its love, but which receives from the majority of people, no other return but ingratitude and insults toward the sacrament of love.

It is our hope that you join us every First Friday of the month to pray together and consecrate our community and our respective families to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and live the grace of the Twelve Promises of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

We begin with the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus followed by Mass and investiture of the Red Scapular for those who signed up (see website or call the office to sign up). In the evening we share a beautiful time of reflection and worship with Taizé Prayer and Eucharistic Adoration.

Our next First Friday devotion will be at **St. Joseph** in Sequim on May 2nd, beginning with the novena at **8:00 am**, followed by Mass at **8:30 am**. Taizé will also be at **St. Joseph** parish at **6:00 pm**.

Our First Saturday Healing Mass is for all in need of healing. We can all use healing, be it spiritual, physical or mental—please plan to join us at **St. Joseph's** on **Saturday, May 3**, at **8:30** AM for a rosary, followed by **9:00** AM Mass.

The **communal anointing** will take place **after the homily**.

One of the most important aspects of the **Fatima message** was Our Lady's request for the **First Saturday devotion**. In the July 13, 1917, apparition at Fatima, Our Lady said to the children, "You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart...I shall come to ask for the Communion of Reparation on the first Saturdays." She came expressly with the request for this devotion when she appeared

to Sister Lucia on Dec. 10, 1925, in Pontevedra, Spain, where she was preparing for religious life.

Sister Lucia wrote of this devotion: "Our Lady presented another rung on the ladder to salvation to her children, increasingly oppressed by sin, to help them live in the grace of God. It was a new invitation to conversion by a Mother who, grieved and concerned about the dangers and fears that her children face, patiently guides them along a more secure path."


