CARMELITE CORNER OF THE OLYMPICS HOLY EXAMPLE OF THE MONTH

Saint Albert of Jerusalem was born in Italy in the mid-12th Century. As a young man, he entered the monastic life where his holiness and leadership gifts soon led to his election as the monastery's prior, which was later followed by his appointment as a diocesan bishop. Recognizing Albert's particular skill in diplomacy, the Pope elevated Albert to Patriarch of Jerusalem in 1205 AD where he navigated particularly difficult times of conflict between Christians and Saracens.



Following a petition from the lay hermits living on Mount Carmel, Albert wrote the Carmelite Rule which endures to this day. While not a Carmelite himself, he is revered by Carmelites as their Lawgiver. In September 1214, during a procession, Albert was stabbed to death by a Catholic hospital director whom Albert had reprimanded and fired for his evil life.


