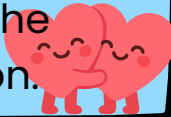

Executive Functioning Skill of the Month

Flexibility

Helping children grow in flexibility is an important life skill we nurture at school and at home. Flexibility means learning to handle changes, try new strategies, and keep going even when things don't go as planned. We support this by modeling calm responses, giving children language to express their feelings, and encouraging problem-solving instead of immediate fixes. When we acknowledge frustration while guiding children to adapt, we help them build resilience, patience, and confidence—skills that will serve them well in the classroom and beyond.
