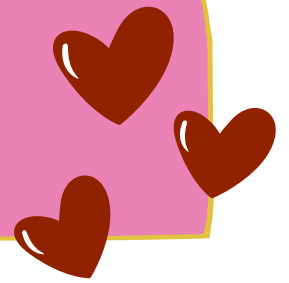




# QUEEN OF ANGELS SCHOOL NEWSLETTER
