CARMELITE CORNER OF THE OLYMPICS

Saint Joseph is a revered figure in Christianity, known as the husband of Mary, the foster father of Jesus, and a model of faith, quiet strength, and diligent work. He is characterized in Sacred Scripture by his obedience and role in protecting the Holy Family, leading them to Egypt and raising Jesus with love and provision, teaching him his trade before fading into the quiet background as Jesus began his public ministry.



The Carmelite Order was founded in the Holy Lands, in the land of Joseph and Jesus. Through this common bond, early Carmelites found resonance in Joseph's life and began celebrating the feast of Saint Joseph as early as the 14th Century, bringing this devotion to the wider Church. In 1680 AD, the Carmelite General Chapter unanimously elected Saint Joseph as the **principal protector of the Carmelite Order**, and in modern times, this title was carried forward for Carmelites to celebrate as a Solemnity.

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

My eyes are always on the Lord, for he rescues my feet from the snare.
Turn to me and have mercy on me, for I am alone and poor.

Cf. Ps 25 (24): 15-16

The story of the (Samaritan) woman at the well is a wonderful model of the work of conversion. While it will be some time yet before we hear Jesus exclaim from the cross ‘I thirst’, His coming to the well in today’s Scripture reflects the true meaning of those words: He thirsts for the salvation of souls!

Notice too, that Jesus shows up first. It is no coincidence that He chose this well, at this time - He knows who is coming and why she comes despite the heat of the noonday sun. In fact, it is likely that He knows that His presence will be another thing she has to

Of the many devotional practices of the Church, the stations of the cross hold a special place. So seriously do we take our walking with the Lord in His Passion & death that a plenary indulgence is attached to their recitation on Fridays in Lent - and the erection of Stations of the Cross in a church may only be done with permission from the bishop (we have those letters of permission framed in each of our parishes!



Whether you can come once or every Friday, come join us as we join the Lord at Calvary!

Thanks to Father Ed, I came across an online TV series called *The Promised Land* (available free on YouTube!). The show tells the story of Moses and the Israelites - but with comedy & style akin to *The Office*. It is a delight to watch and one that I am happy to recommend to you.

This Sunday’s first reading stood out to me, particularly the description of the people having “grumbled” against Moses. C.S. Lewis, in his book *The Great Divorce* writes that “Hell begins with a grumbling mood... which will BE hell unless it is nipped in the bud.”

This Lent, may we allow the Lord to turn our grumbles into praise!

But come she does, and the conversation that ensues is delightful in every way. She is frank in expressing her own beliefs and the Lord receives them, and her without judgment! He instead gives her the gift of true wisdom - and then offers her the water of life.

Having been so well-received (despite her standing in society and her boldness in speaking so to not just a man, but a prophet!), Jesus teases out of her the truth of her situation - a confession of life that ultimate leads not only to her salvation, but her own proclamation of the Gospel “Come see”! May we likewise meet, receive, and proclaim Christ.

¿POR QUÉ LOS CATÓLICOS HACEN ESO?

La historia de la mujer Samaritana del pozo es una modelo importante del trabajo de conversión. Aunque era bien antes de las palabras de Jesús en la cruz ("Tengo sed"), su venido al pozo ilumina la verdad de sus palabras: ¡su sed es para las almas!

Observe que Jesús aparece primero. No es casualidad que Él eligió ese pozo, a esa hora - sabía quién era venía y por qué venía entonces, a pesar del calor del sol del mediodía. De hecho, es probable que sabía que Su presencia sería otro obstáculo que tendría que superar, porque ella eligió ese momento precisamente

De todas las prácticas devocionales de la Iglesia, los Estaciones de la Cruz son especiales. Ellas son tan significativas que la Iglesia ofrezca una indulgencia plenaria a los que lo rezan en los Viernes de la Cuaresma. ¡Para tenerlos en la iglesia se necesita el permiso del obispo! (¡Tomen esas cartas de permiso en las sacristías de cada una de nuestras parroquias!)



Ya sea que puedas venir una vez o todos los viernes, ¡ven con nosotros mientras nos unimos al Señor en el Calvario!

Padre Ed me recomendó un programa de televisión llamado *La Tierra Prometida* (¡disponible gratis en Youtube!), que es la historia de Moisés y los Israelitas - con el humor y el estilo de la serie *The Office*. ¡Te lo recomiendo con mucho gusto!

La primera lectura de este Domingo me llamó la atención en la descripción de la gente que murmuran contra Moisés. C.S. Lewis, en su libro *El Gran Divorcio*, escribió que 'El infierno comienza con un estado de ánimo murmurante... que SERÁ un infierno a menos que se corte de raíz.'

Que en este tiempo de Cuaresma, permitamos que el Señor transforme nuestras murmullos a las alabanzas!


