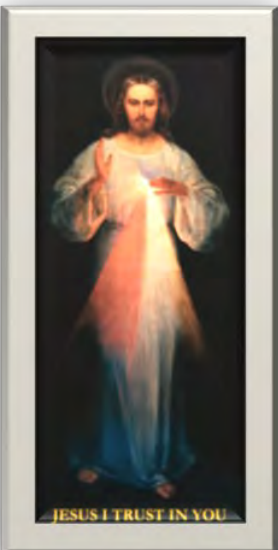

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

Hosanna to the Son of David;
blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, the King of Israel. Hosanna in the highest.

Cf. Mt 21: 9

I still remember the first time I came across a crucifix that impressed upon me the ugliness of Christ's sacrifice and death. The corpus hanging from the cross was wracked in pain, the fingers curled around the nails, the legs twisted in silent agony, the downturned face hidden in shadow and barely recognizable as human, the long scars of the wounds opened across practically every inch of exposed flesh.

Every time I walked into that parish, I avoided



looking at that crucifix....until one day what I was doing hit me square between the eyes: I was joining the Apostles in running from the cross....and Him Who hung on it.

As we consider the Passion of

Jesus today and in the coming Triduum, we are not called to inflict torture, suffering, or even discomfort upon ourselves. It is entirely reasonable that we would choose *not* to focus on the gruesomeness of Christ's sufferings. But whether we look up at the cross or down at the ground, let us draw near to Him in His suffering, standing witness to His saving offering. And above all, let us join His mother and the beloved Apostle in simply accompanying Jesus at the hill of Calvary.

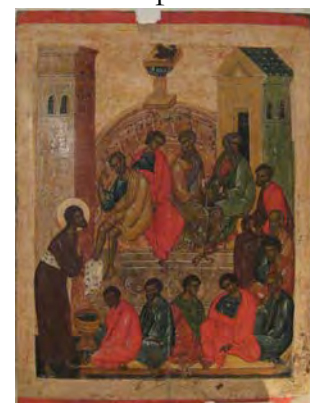
"I have sinned in betraying innocent blood." Too late, Judas realized his part in the passion and death of Jesus. This side of heaven, we can not know if his sorrow and despair led him to more than self-destruction, though we can hope & pray that it did!



For ourselves, let us take that extra step - not only of recognizing our own culpability but of presenting our brokenness to the Lord! It is for this reason He suffered & died: that we may be made whole.

Holy Thursday marks the institution of the priesthood and of the Eucharist, as well as the commissioning of the Apostles. The tradition of the washing of feet at this Mass expresses both the universal and ministerial priesthood. Every baptized person is called to live out the sanctifying (universal!) priesthood in their particular vocation. And every priest is called to administer the sacraments in the person of Christ.

With the washing of the feet of twelve men this year, we take time to focus on the ministerial priesthood - may we pray that God call many men to serve as priests!

¿POR QUÉ LOS CATÓLICOS HACEN ESO?

"¡Hosanna en las alturas!
¡Bendito tú que viste con abundante misericordia!"

Cf. Mt 21: 9

Ya recuerdo la primera vez que encontré un crucifijo que mostró la fealdad del sacrificio y muerte de Cristo. Su cuerpo colgante, atormentado por el dolor, sus dedos curvados alrededor de las uñas, sus piernas retorcidas de agonía, su rostro vuelto hacia abajo, oculto en la sombra y apenas reconocible como humano; las largas cicatrices de las heridas abiertas a lo largo de prácticamente cada centímetro de carne expuesta.



Cada vez que entraba esa parroquia, evitaba mirarla a ese crucifijo... hasta me daba pena lo que era haciendo: uniéndome a los Apóstoles para huir de la cruz...y de Aquel que colgó de ella.

Al contemplar hoy, y durante el próximo Triduo, la Pasión de Jesús, no estamos llamados a infligirnos tortura, sufrimiento ni siquiera incomodidad. Es totalmente razonable que optemos por no centrar nuestra atención en la crudeza de los padecimientos de Cristo. Pero, ya sea que miremos hacia la cruz o hacia el suelo, acerquémonos a Él en su sufrimiento, siendo testigos de su ofrenda salvadora. Y, por encima de todo, unámonos a su Madre y al Apóstol amado para, simplemente, acompañar a Jesús en el monte Calvario.

“Pequé, entregando la sangre de un inocente.” Demasiado tarde, Judas realizó su parte en la pasión y muerte de Jesús. Este lado de los cielos, no sabemos si su pena y desesperación lo llevaron a algo más que la autodestrucción -



¡pero esperamos y oramos que lo hicieron!

Por nosotros mismos, que hacemos ahora lo que el no pudiera hacer: no solo reconociendo nuestra culpabilidad ¡sino también presentándole al Señor! Es para eso que sufrió y murió: para que seamos sanados.

El Jueves Santo conmemora la institución del sacerdocio y de la Eucaristía, así como el envío de los Apóstoles. La tradición del lavatorio de los pies en esta Misa expresa tanto el sacerdocio universal como el ministerial. Todo bautizado está llamado a vivir el sacerdocio santificador (¡universal!) en su propia vocación particular. Y todo sacerdote está llamado a administrar los sacramentos en la persona de Cristo.

Con el lavatorio de los pies a doce hombres este año, nos detenemos a reflexionar sobre el sacerdocio ministerial; ¡oremos para que Dios llame a muchos hombres a servir como sacerdotes!
