WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

The merciful love of the Lord fills the earth;
by the word of the Lord the heavens were made, alleluia.

Cf. Ps 33 (32): 5-6

While we know that we are not *the* Good Shepherd, it is a legitimate question to ask 'am *I* a good shepherd?' Though we humbly follow Christ, our Good Shepherd, He has entrusted each of us to shepherd others and each other within our own domains.

The alternatives to following the example of the Good Shepherd are stark - those who fail to do so are thieves and robbers! What that looks like in our lives may not - at least at first glance - appear to be theft or robbery, but closer examination reveals the truth! Whenever we choose selfishly, act uncharitably, or

withhold the gifts of faith, hope, and charity, we are stealing for ourselves the very gifts we are meant to share.

The eagle-eyed among us may recognize that one of the resources I regularly rely on is the 'Saint of the Day' feature from the Vatican News website (www.vaticannews.va). They often include brief (or not-so-brief!) summaries of the saint(s) of a given day - well worth adding to your daily reading!

The Lord lays out the results of those actions: slaughter and destruction - not simply in ways material but in the more profound realms of the spiritual and eternal: we kill and destroy the very spirits of those we choose not to love.

Recently a parishioner asked me a question I'd bet is shared by many: 'Father, why do you add water to the wine at Mass?'

At the beginning of Mass today, we prayed that God would 'lead us to a share in the joys of heaven, so that the humble flock may reach where the brave Shepherd has gone before'. The great joy of our vocation is not only that we are led by God nor that He is leading us to heaven - awesome though those both are! - but that He entrusts to us share in the leading itself. In receiving that trust, may we take care to model in all things the Good Shepherd.

The answer can be found in the prayer the priest or deacon quietly says as he pours a little wine into the chalice: "By the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity."

As Jesus is both human and divine - without diminishment or mixing - so this liturgical gesture expresses our hope to be united to the Divine through Him!

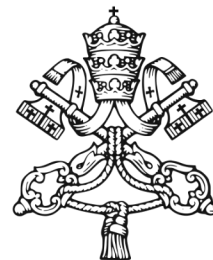
Aunque sabemos que no somos El Buen Pastor, es una pregunta legítima hacernos '¿soy *yo* un buen pastor?', porque Él ha confiado a cada uno de nosotros pastorear a las demás dentro de nuestros propios dominios.

Las alternativas son tajantes: ¡quienes no lo hacen son ladrones y bandidos! La forma en que esto se manifiesta en nuestras vidas puede no parecer — al menos a primera vista — un acto de robo o pillaje; sin embargo, un examen más detenido revela la verdad. Cada vez que nos negamos a compartir los dones de la fe, la esperanza y la caridad, estamos robando para nosotros mismos precisamente aquellos dones que estamos llamados a compartir.

El Señor expone las consecuencias de tales acciones: matanza y destrucción; no solo en el ámbito material, sino en las esferas más profundas de lo espiritual y lo eterno: matamos y destruimos los propios espíritus de aquellos a quienes decidimos no amar.

Al comienzo de la Misa de hoy, oramos para que Dios "condúcenos a la asamblea gozosa del cielo, para que la debilidad del rebaño llegue hasta donde le ha precedido la fortaleza del Pastor". La inmensa alegría de nuestra vocación no reside únicamente en que somos guiados por Dios, ni en que Él nos conduce hacia el cielo — ¡por muy maravillosos que sean ambos hechos! — sino en que Él nos confía la participación en la tarea misma de guiar. Al recibir esa confianza, procuremos imitar en todo al Buen Pastor.

Cada semana trato resaltar unos de los santos que se celebran en nuestro calendario litúrgico. Por ejemplo, en esta semana celebramos el memorial de San Catalina de Siena (29 de abril) y lo de San Atanasio (2 de mayo), siendo ambos, además, Doctores de la Iglesia.

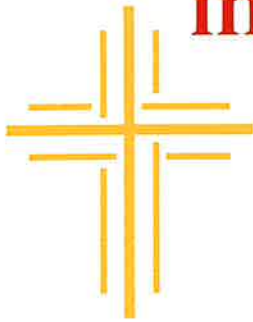
Un feligrés me hizo una pregunta probablemente comparten muchos: '¿Padre, porque mezclan el agua con el vino durante la Misa?'

The Gate | From the desk of Fr. Ed

"I am the gate."

Jesus, not shy about the Truth, points to Himself as the gate by which we enter heaven, by which we enter the Kingdom, by which we enter the peace of God. We are so blessed during our Easter Season, moving from Divine Mercy Sunday (4/12/26) through the disciples of Emmaus (4/19/26) and now on to Jesus the gate. All point to the same person.

On Divine Mercy Sunday we heard Jesus' voice calling us to His peace. Our God is a God of peace. When He breathes on the apostles Jesus institutes the Sacrament of Reconciliation, granting the power to forgive to those same apostles and subsequent bishops and priests. This is the ultimate peace, to know that we are forgiven of our sins, that we are right with God. This is the first Maxim of Christian Perfection that Blessed Rosmini counsels us to adopt, that is, "to be just".

What does justice have to do with mercy? Aren't they opposed to one another? No, because God is both infinitely just and infinitely merciful. To be just is to be right with God, especially in His attribute of mercy. Justice gives a person (including God), their due. What do I owe a person? To God we owe worship, reverence, obedience and love. This is not because God needs such things. That's a broken human projection. It's because of who He is that we owe Him these things. God is infinite love, He deserves to be worshipped. That's why we adore the Blessed Sacrament.

The image of Divine Mercy reveals Jesus revealing His Heart to us. From His Heart flow the red ray and the white ray, representing the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist. Jesus describes His Heart as a font of mercy. He tells us to choose mercy before His justice arrives. It will come eventually. If our sins are forgiven, we have nothing to fear.

The disciples of Emmaus recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread, having had the Scriptures unpacked for them, and their discouragement lifted. Now they become evangelists.

Jesus' voice speaks through all three Gospels along with the very Mass. Let us pray to recognize the Gate that we must pass through. His Heart is wide open for us.
