## CARMELITE CORNER OF THE OLYMPICS HOLY EXAMPLE OF THE MONTH

**Saint Mary Madgalene de Pazzi, O.Carm**, was born into nobility in Italy in the 16th Century. She exhibited a deep prayer life as a child and entered Carmel at the age of 18. Her life as a nun was filled with difficulties which she joyfully embraced. Mary was known for her ecstatic visions, many occurring after receiving the Eucharist, as well as the depth of her mystical theology. Filled with a burning desire for the renewal of the Church, and keenly aware of the urgent need for reform, she presented herself as an offering to God on behalf of the "anointed ones" (i.e. priests). Her hope was that priests would again be witnesses to the world, so that the lapsed might return to the Church.

Mary Magdalene de Pazzi's spirituality has love at its center. We are created by God who is love, with love and by love. Love is the way we turn to God, and love is the measure by which we will be judged.

# WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Proclaim a joyful sound and let it be heard; proclaim to the ends of the earth:  
The Lord has freed his people, alleluia.

*Cf. Is 48: 20*

Here in the United States, we celebrate Mother's Day, honoring those women who give of themselves in biological, adoptive, foster, and spiritual motherhood. Interestingly, this holiday was established in the United States only relatively recently (1914), with the first celebration oriented towards international peace - with mothers asking that their husbands and sons not be killed in wars. (A still-relevant cause, deserving of our attention and prayers, especially given recent events!)

As Catholics, the month of May contains not only this day honoring the mothers in our particular families but also Mary, mother of God and the Church. In parishes around the world, there is often a crowning of the statues of Mary ('May crowning'), as well as additional devotional practices - sometimes even processions! - honoring her motherhood.



Put together, we have a month chock-full of celebration and prayer! We honor the mothers in our lives, we lift up in prayer also those mothers who have no one to pray for them, especially those mothers who have suffered and yet still suffer the loss of their children, and we honor Mary, Mother of us all. Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the love of Her Son, and our own example, may we generously share the love we have received from our moms!

Thank you to all who came to the BASH ("Building a Scholastic Heritage") school fundraiser earlier this month! It was a *blast* to attend (my first time!) and we raised over \$100,000 (!) in support of our school here on the Olympic Peninsula.



Growing up, I never had the opportunity to take part in Catholic education - at least, not until I went to seminary! We are blessed to have a Catholic school right in the middle of our parish family. To all of our parents, grandparents, and godparents: now is a great time to explore how your children might benefit from being students at our school!

At all of our churches, there is on or near the altar candles and a crucifix. This is in accordance with the instructions given to us for the Mass, which say that "either on the altar or near it, there is to be a cross, with the figure of Christ crucified upon it, a cross clearly visible to the assembled people" (GIRM 308) and that "on or next to the altar are to be placed candlesticks with lighted candles: at least two in any celebration, or even four or six, especially for a Sunday Mass or Holyday of Obligation" (GIRM 117).

These symbols help draw our hearts and minds to the Lord as we follow His command to 'do this in memory of Me'!

(Todavía algo relevante, digna de nuestra atención y oración, ¡especialmente hoy en día!).

En la Iglesia, el mes de mayo contiene no solamente este día para honrar a las madres de



nuestras familias individuales sino también María, Madre de Dios y de la Iglesia. En parroquias de todo el mundo, hay una costumbre de coronar estatuas de María, a veces con procesiones

que honran su maternidad.

¡Es decir que mayo es un mes lleno de celebraciones y oraciones! Honramos las madres en nuestras vidas, oremos por las madres que no tienen nadie orando por ellas - especialmente las madres que han sufrido y sufren por la muerte de sus niños - y honramos a María, Madre de todos nosotros. Por la intercesión de la Virgen María, el amor de Su Hijo, y por nuestro propio ejemplo, ¡que compartamos generosamente el amor hemos recibido de nuestras madres!

¡Gracias a todos que venían al evento 'BASH' ('Building a Scholastic Heritage') para recaudar fondos para nuestra escuela! Fue bien divertido asistir (¡mi primera vez!) y recaudamos más de \$100,000 (!) en apoyo a nuestra escuela.



Cuando yo estaba creciendo, no tenía la oportunidad participar en educación católica - ¡por los menos, no fue hasta que ingresé al seminario! Estamos bendecidos para tener una escuela católica en medio de nuestro territorio. A todos nuestros padres, abuelos, y padrinos: ¡ahora es un momento excelente para explorar cómo sus hijos podrían beneficiarse de ser estudiantes en nuestra escuela!

En todos de nuestra iglesia, hay velas y un crucifijo en o cerca del altar, por los instrucciones dado para la misa que dice "sobre el altar, o cerca de él, colóquese una cruz con la imagen de Cristo crucificado, que pueda ser vista sin obstáculos por el pueblo congregado" (IGMR 308) y "(s)obre el altar, o cerca de él, colóquese en todas las celebraciones por lo menos dos candeleros, o también cuatro o seis, especialmente si se trata de una Misa dominical o festiva de precepto" (IGMR, 117)

¡Estos símbolos nos ayudan enfocarnos en el Señor mientras seguimos su mandato de "hagan esto en memoria Mía"!

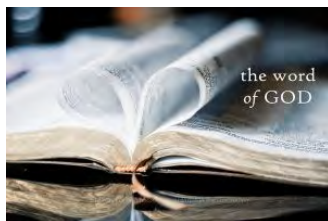
