WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

Growing up, I was blessed with a sort of dual citizenship in churches. My folks are staunch Catholics, so we always went to Mass each weekend - and when I was old enough, I took up altar serving and eventually fell in love with the Mass (and now I get to offer it daily!).

At the same time, we went to Protestant churches every weekend (Saturday vigil Mass, Sunday morning Protestant services). My mother is an organist and it often turned out that the opportunities to play the organ in a church were within those communities!

Next week Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or 'Corpus Christi'. The last major solemnity after the conclusion of the Easter season, it is meant to be a major celebration!



Within the Mass, there is only one major prescribed difference: the sequence 'Lauda Sion' in praise of Christ & the Eucharist. But the Church exhorts pastors and parishes to conclude this Mass with a Eucharistic procession in the streets - proclaiming Christ to all around. And so we will do after Masses at all our parishes this weekend - come join in this celebration and witness to our Lord!

On Friday, June 12, the Church will celebrate the solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In his recent pastoral letter "[Learn from Me for I Am Meek and Humble of Heart](#)", Archbishop Etienne exhorts us all to embrace a devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus - but especially so on this solemnity!

Across our parish family, special Masses will be offered in each region. I encourage you and your families to plan on coming to one of these celebrations as we ask the Lord to make our hearts more like His own.



One of the things I absolutely *adore* about the faith of our separated brethren is their deep emphasis on study and knowledge of Sacred Scripture. And no passage is better known than today's

gospel, John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." In one sentence, Saint John sums up Christian faith!

For Christians, there is a convicting question implicit in this passage: do we *actually* believe? Do I place my heart, my life, my hope in the Lord? As we venture into Ordinary Time, let us ask God for great(er!) faith, that we may truly live and proclaim that faith at all times.



Bendito sea Dios Padre, y su Hijo Unigénito,

Al crecer, estaba bendecido con una especie de doble ciudadanía en iglesias. Mis padres son católicos acérrimos y por eso siempre fuimos a Misa cada fin de la semana. Cuando tuve edad suficiente, estaba un monaguillo y me encantó la Misa (¡que ahora puedo ofrecer a diario!).

Al mismo tiempo, fuimos a iglesias protestantes cada fin de la semana (misas de vigilia, servicios protestantes en los domingos). Mi madre es organista y ¡la mayoría de las veces oportunidades tocar el órgano eran en esas comunidades!



Unos de las cosas que aprecio de la fe de nuestros hermanos separados es su profundo énfasis en estudiar y saber las escrituras. Y ningún pasaje es más conocido que el evangelio de hoy,

Juan 3:16: "Tanto amó Dios al mundo, que le entregó a su Hijo único, para que todo el que crea en él no perezca, sino que tenga la vida eterna." ¡En una sentencia, San Juan resume la fe cristiana!

Para cristianos, hay una pregunta implícita en este pasaje que nos confronta: ¿realmente creemos? ¿Pongo mi corazón, mi esperanza en el Señor? Como entramos en el Tiempo Ordinario, que pidamos de Dios una fe más grande, para que vivamos y proclamamos esa fe en todo momento.

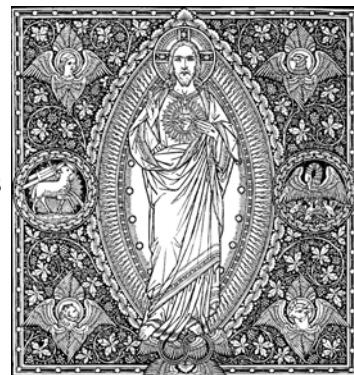
El prójimo domingo, celebremos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo o 'Corpus Christi'. El último solemnidad después del conculso del tiempo pascual, ¡estaba destinado a ser una gran celebración!



Adentra de la misa, solo hay una diferencia importante: la secuencia 'Lauda Sion' que alaba el Señor y la eucaristía. Pero la Iglesia exhorta pastores y parroquias a concluir esta misa con una procesión eucarística en las calles - proclamando Cristo a todos. Entonces, lo haremos después de misas en cada de nuestras parroquias este fin de la semana - ¡ven y únete a esta celebración, dando testimonio al mundo!

El viernes, 12 junio, la Iglesia celebrará la Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. En su reciente carta pastoral, "[Aprendan de mí, que soy manso y humilde de corazón](#)", arzobispo Etienne nos exhortó a vivir la devoción al Sagrado Corazón - ¡especialmente en esta solemnidad!

En nuestra familia parroquial, misas especiales serán ofrecido en cada región. Les animo a ti y sus familias venir a unos de estas celebraciones mientras le pedimos al Señor que haga nuestros corazones más semejantes al Suyo.

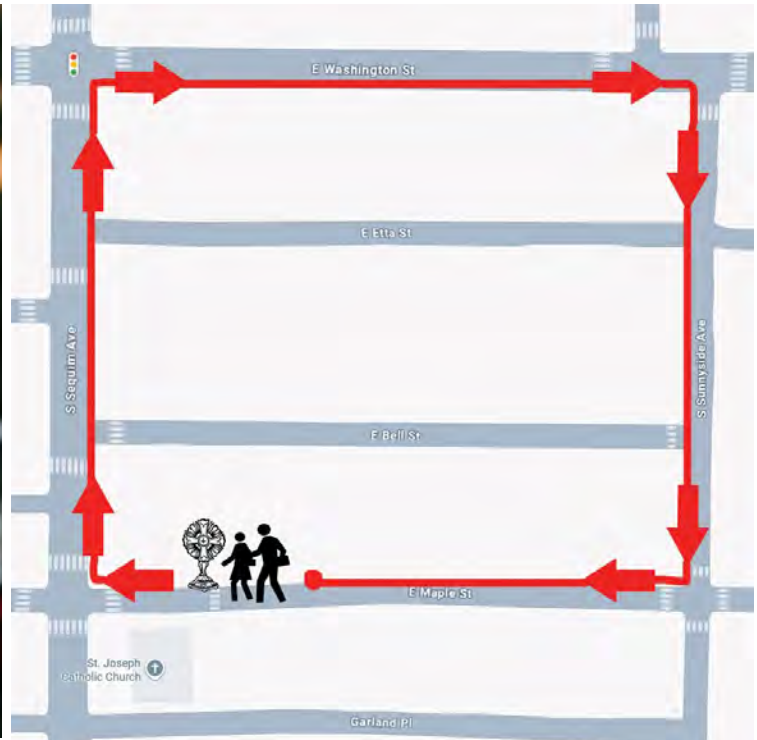
