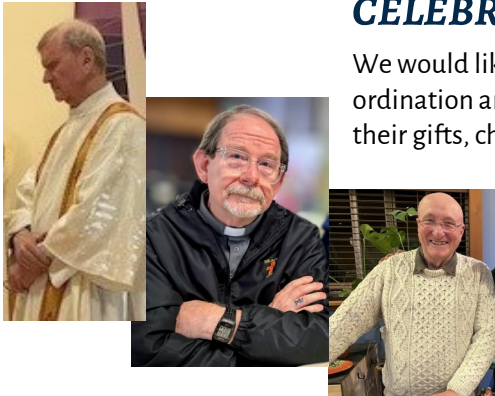

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens?

This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

Cf. Acts 1: 11

As the proper form of the *Communicantes* of Eucharistic Prayer I says, today we celebrate "the most sacred day on which your Only Begotten Son, our Lord, placed at the right hand of your glory our weak human nature, which he had united to himself".

Later, after the Memorial Acclamation, the priest prays that "these gifts be borne by the hands of your holy Angel to your altar on high in the sight of your divine majesty, so that all of us who through this participation at the altar receive the most holy Body and Blood of your Son".



All of this takes place through the gifts over which the priest prayed "may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity".

The confusion and fear the Apostles felt at the time of Christ's ascension gave way to understanding that Jesus was not abandoning them or us. Rather, at His ascension, Jesus takes our humanity to the Father, placing not just Himself but all of mankind (us!) at God's right hand. Even more, He entrusts us with the responsibility and authority of bringing Him - spiritually and Eucharistically - to the whole world. So strengthened, we may cooperate with His ongoing work in our lives and that our lives may further His work in the world!

One of the delights of our Catholic faith is how it is both rooted in the joys of God's creation while still being oriented towards eternity. It is for this reason we have things like holy water fonts to bless ourselves, bells to draw our attention to prayer, and incense to honor the Lord.



But not every tradition is in the church - we also have traditions in our own homes and with our families. An Ascension picnic is one of those practices, where Catholics go out to a hilltop (much like the one Jesus ascended from) and have a picnic together in celebration of Christ's return to heaven!

From the announcements last weekend and my blog post ([read it at fathermaurer.com!](http://fathermaurer.com)), you likely already know that Queen of Angels parish is again available for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle 24/7. I am grateful for the patience folks have had as we made the necessary preparations for that change, as well as for the great devotion to our Eucharistic Lord!

This strikes me as a particularly opportune moment to consider how ALL of us might make prayer before the Blessed Sacrament a part of our regular routine, coming to visit, pray before and adore the Lord!





¿POR QUÉ LOS CATÓLICOS HACEN ESO?

Reyes de la tierra, cantad a Dios, tocad al Señor que asciende a lo más alto de los cielos; su majestad y su poder sobre las nubes. Aleluya.

Cf. Hcb 1: 11

En la forma propio del parte 'reunidos en comunión' de la plegaria eucarística I, dice que "celebramos él día santísimo en que tu Hijo único, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, habiendo tomado nuestra débil condición humana, lo exaltó a la derecha de tu gloria".

Más adelante, después de la aclamación memorial, el sacerdote ora que "esta ofrenda sea llevada a tu presencia, hasta el altar del cielo, por manos de tu Ángel, para que cuanto recibimos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de tu Hijo, al participar aquí de este altar, seamos colmados de gracia y bendición."



Todo eso pasa por los dones sobre que el sacerdote oró "haz que compartamos la divinidad de quien se ha dignado participar de nuestra humanidad".

El confusión y medio de los Apóstoles cuando Jesús ascendió eventualmente se convirtió en comprensión - ¡que Jesus no nos abandonó! Más bien, en su ascensión, Jesús toma nuestra humanidad al Padre, colocando no solo a Sí mismo, sino a toda la humanidad (¡nosotros!) a la diestra de Dios. ¡Y hay más! Él nos confía la responsabilidad y autoridad de traerle - espiritual y eucarísticamente - a todo el mundo. Que cooperamos con su trabajo en nuestras vidas para que continuamos su misión de ofrecer salvación a todos.

Unos de los delitos de nuestra fe es el hecho que es fundado en las alegrías de creación mientras que también es orientado a eternidad. Para este razón tenemos fuentes del agua santo para bendecirnos, las campanas para llamar atención a oración, y el incienso para honrar al Señor.



Pero no toda tradición es adentro la parroquia - tenemos también tradiciones en nuestras casas, con nuestras familias. Un pícnic de la Ascencion es unas de las prácticas en que los católicos salen a la cima de una colina (como aquel desde el cual ascendió Jesús) y hacer un pícnic para celebrar el regreso de Crista al cielo.

Después de los anuncios de los últimos fines de semana y mí artículo en mi blog ([léelo en fathermaurer.com](http://fathermaurer.com)), probablemente ya sabes que 24/7 adoración del Santísimo Sacramento en el tabernáculo es disponible de nuevo en la parroquia de Reina de los Ángeles. Estoy agradecido por la paciencia de todo mientras hicimos las preparaciones necesarios - ¡y por su devoción a nuestro Señor Eucarístico!

Me parece que este es un momento particularmente oportuno para considerar como TODOS de nosotros podríamos hacer oración antes el Santísimo un parte de nuestra rutina regular, ¡para visitar, orar ante y adorar el Señor!
