Last Sunday, we heard in the Gospel of the comfort and care of the Lord for us ("fear no one"). Today, we hear of the cost of discipleship: "that to be a disciple of the Lord comes with great cost - but also great reward!

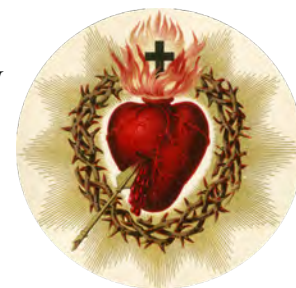
This last week I was moved by a gesture from our local Catholic radio station (Sacred Heart Radio). They reserved a bulletin board in Aberdeen to send a message of support to all priests. Their strategy was most impressive: choosing a bulletin board on the side of the highway where every priest would pass by and see it on their way to Ocean Shores for the Priest Days conference - it was a delightful surprise for us all!



I want to also share my gratitude with you all for your support for all of us priests (with or without bulletin boards!). We are blessed to be with you and to serve you.

For me, the question of what (or who) I love more than Jesus pricks my conscience. I want to respond that, of course there is nothing and no one I love more than the Lord.

But also, what is evidenced in my decisions? How many times have I decided to do not what He but what I want? Which priorities do I place above those towards which the Lord calls me? Although some of them might even be good, are they the good things *God* desires or expressions of what I desire?

At the center of discipleship is the cross - that of Christ and our own. Through the cross, we participate in the sacrifice of Christ so that we - and the world! - may share in the salvation He won. May we not be afraid to take up our cross and follow Him.

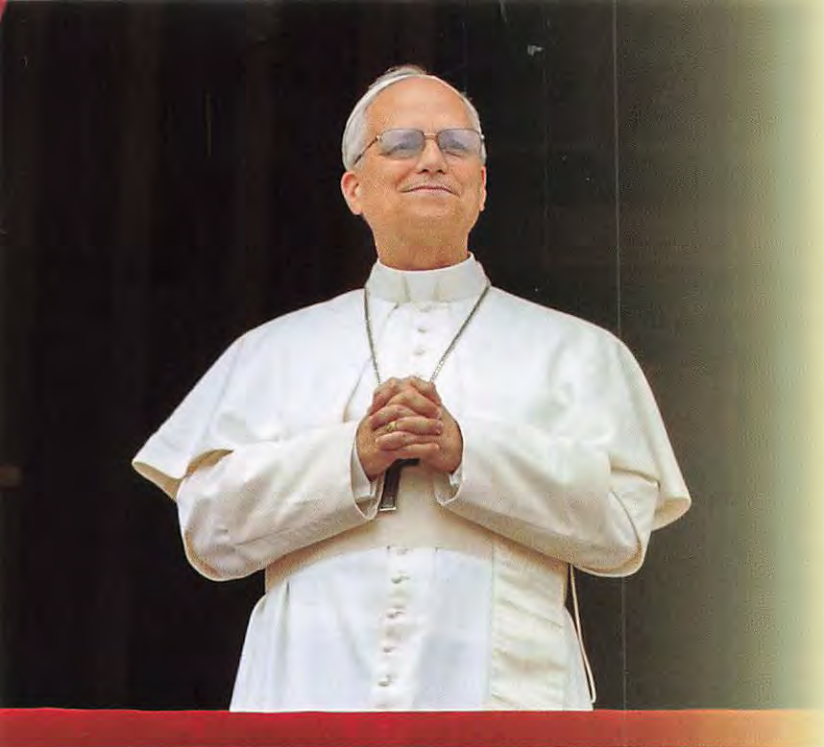

Queen of Angels Parish, along with Father Demetrius Juneman, OSB and the Sisters of St. Ann of Victoria B.C., opened Queen of Angels School in 1926. When the school was opened Bishop O'Dea came from Seattle to bless and dedicate the new school and convent buildings. The first school year (1926-1927) brought 135 pupils in grades one through eight. Enrollment increased to 140 by the end of that year. A 9<sup>th</sup> grade was added for a short time.

Queen of Angels School was first built as a 1-story building (see photo). In 1930 a second story was added to the school building to add more classrooms. Enrollment continued to grow for many years. The neighboring building was the convent which served as the residence for all the nuns who taught at the school.

In 1947 the Sisters of St. Anne were recalled to Victoria, B.C. and the Sisters of St. Joseph, from Newark, New Jersey, replaced them. They taught here until the mid-1970s and were eventually replaced by lay teachers. In 1974 Queen of Angels School expanded with a Kindergarten and then in 1981 added a Preschool program.

Since the convent was no longer being used for a residence, a large remodel was undertaken. In the late 1990s a new building was built between the school and the convent bridging the two buildings. The convent was remodeled to include classrooms, a computer lab, a science lab, a restroom, staff lounge, and work rooms. The connecting building serves as the main office for the school. In October of 1997 construction was complete. The Reverend James Picton, Vicar of the Archdiocese of Seattle, along with Father John Wilkie, Pastor of Queen of Angels Parish, presided over the dedication ceremony and blessing of the new building and newly remodeled convent building.

Today, Queen of Angels School serves roughly 175 students, using the same 100 year old school building! In 2026 our school celebrates its Centennial celebration with many events planned for alumni and current students.
