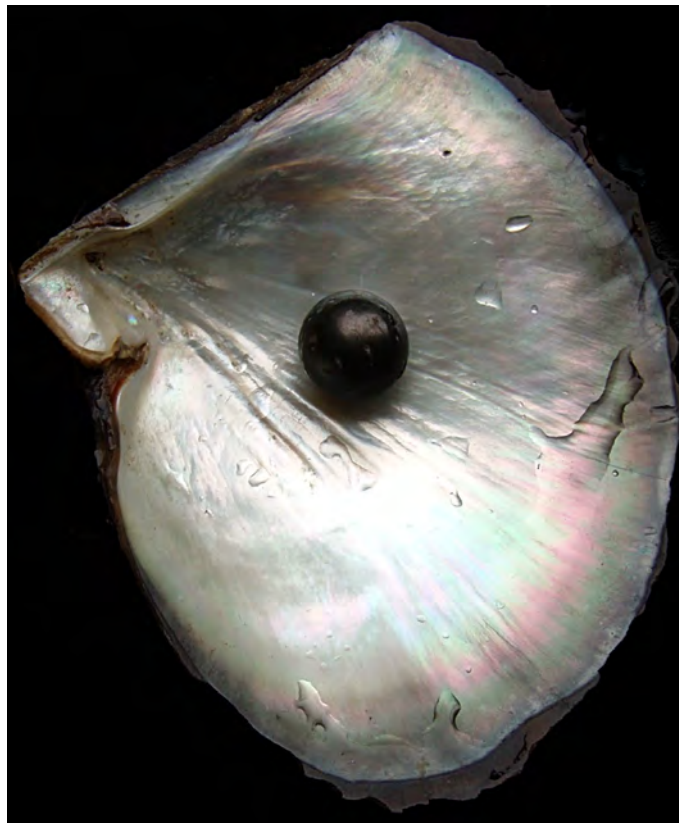

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

God is in his holy place, God who unites those who dwell in his house;
he himself gives might and strength to his people.

Cf. Ps 68 (67): 6-7, 36

If the Lord were to appear to you in a dream
and offer you whatever you wanted, what
would you ask for?

This was the dilemma of Solomon in today's
first reading - and what a thing to struggle
with! His response was perfect: an
understanding heart to judge God's people and
to distinguish right from wrong. Who among
us could have offered a better petition than
this?

When I consider my own prayers, what I value



is illuminated
- along with
what I do not
sufficiently
value. Where
does my
neighbor fit
into my

prayers? What are the urgent needs that I
ought to be focused on? How am I including
even my enemies in my prayers for God's
grace?

An understanding heart - what a gift! And for
what? So that we might judge (rightly!) among
all that the Lord has given us and distinguish
right from wrong. All of us need this wisdom -
and we can receive it, if only we would ask.

Each Sunday we offer the first mass pro
populo (for the people of the parish - all of
them!). May the Lord help us make a worthy
offering in our words and actions.

On Wednesday, July 29, we
celebrate the memorial of
Saints Martha, Mary, and
Lazarus. We remember
them for their encounters
with the Lord, their faith,
and the miracle of the
resurrection of Lazarus.



Our parish family might consider these saints
as patrons, especially in the charism of
hospitality - especially given how many visit
the Olympic Peninsula and our evangelical
mission to invite all to encounter the Lord in
Faith. Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, pray
for us that we may also have and share the
friendship that you had with the Lord!

Okay. I know that it is not as exciting as
astronauts going to space, but we need YOUR

has helped out for ever, I am not asking other
people or the person sitting next to you at

Coats for Kids Program

What is the Coats for Kids program?

The Knights of Columbus James G. Caldwell and Saints Joseph and Mary Sequim Council No. 8455 are honored to participate in the international Coats for Kids program this year and are seeking the support of Olympic Peninsula Catholic parishioners, including you! This program has a major positive impact on local children through its goal of ensuring that as few children as possible go without a coat during the winter. Temperatures on the Olympic Peninsula can plummet to below freezing in the winter, which can be dangerous for children who lack adequate clothing. The Knights aim to help ensure no child is left frigid in what is supposed to be a season of holiday light and warmth. You have an opportunity to help us do this by donating to our local Coats for Kids program collection drive.

Why should I help?

With the help of generous, individual contributions from parishioners, the North Olympic Peninsula Knights of Columbus Councils donated a total of 68 cases (816 coats) to needy children on the Olympic Peninsula in 2025. The job starts anew every year as new children arrive and older children grow out of old clothing. The coats we provide are high quality, heavy duty winter coats. The average cost for a case of 12 coats this year is \$309.

How can I help?

Our goal is to ensure that as few children as possible on the North Olympic Peninsula go without a winter coat. Any parishioner can help us meet our goal and make a direct impact in the lives of Olympic Peninsula children. Monetary donations are tax-deductible and can be made by writing a check to "Columbus Charities" and mailing it to P.O. Box 382, Sequim, WA 98382. Please be sure to write "Coats for Kids, Council 2260" or "Coats for Kids, Council 8455" on the memo line. A donation of any amount will be greatly appreciated because it will help us reach our goal. Please contact District Deputy Jim Fryxell at (360) 670-3659 if you have any questions about this program or how you can help. The local Knights Councils must purchase the coats by August 25th to ensure they arrive in time for the cold weather, so please don't wait to contribute!

Who will this help?

This campaign involves our entire parish family and spans the North Olympic Peninsula in both Clallam and Jefferson counties. Any child in our community who needs a coat for winter is eligible to receive a coat through the program. The coats are distributed to children primarily through our local schools. Your local Knights invite you to join us in living out our Catholic faith by making a difference in the life of a child in need this winter!

Seminarian Aid & Priest Support

Queen of Angels Catholic Women (QACW), which disbanded few years ago, were members of Archdiocesan Council Catholic Women (ACCW). For over 60 years, ACCW raised monies for seminarians and retired priests. Monies were put into an endowment fund. The Archdiocese receives dividends/interest from these funds annually. In 2026 the amount realized from the endowment investment is \$110,549.84 for seminarian education and \$43,867.00 for retired priests. St Francis Guild has continued to raise money to send to the seminarians directly. The flea market August 28-29 proceeds will be used to support the seminarians.
