## CARMELITE CORNER OF THE OLYMPICS HOLY EXAMPLE OF THE MONTH

Blessed Isidore Bakanja was born in the Congo region of Africa. To survive as a young boy, Isidore had to work on farms run by Belgian colonials. Isadore converted to Christianity in 1906 at the age of eighteen after receiving the Gospel from Trappist missionaries. Delighted with his new faith, he shared it with whomever would listen. This enraged the Belgians, many of whom were hardened atheists.

One particularly cruel manager who hated Christians tore off Isidore's Brown Scapular and scourged him more than 100 times with a whip imbedded with nails, tearing the skin off Isidore's back and exposing his bones. Isidore never recovered. Just prior to his death, the missionaries urged Isidore to pray for his torturer. "Certainly I shall pray for him," he responded. "When I am in heaven, I shall pray for him very much." He died in August 1909, Rosary in hand and the Scapular of Our Lady of Mt Carmel around his neck.

# WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever.

For we who come to Mass each Sunday and/or pray daily (especially the rosary), the 'Our Father' is easy to offer without thinking about what we are saying - and what *are* we saying?



That we are sons and daughters of the Almighty God, creator of all the world, judge of the living and the dead, fount of all that was, is, and is to come.

To Him we dare to say 'Father'... by

His own invitation!

In Christ we receive honor greater than the prophet Elijah would ever have imagined, greater than Peter would have been able to believe (at least, at first): Jesus raises us up not out of water but from our sins, to participate in His dignity as the Son of God. We are not worthy of this gift, but He makes us worthy, if we but trust in him, allowing His Spirit to move and change our hearts, as we echo Peter's words: 'Lord, save me!'.

In the life of the modern Church, we are rediscovering the dignity of the order of the diaconate. We are blessed here on the Olympic Peninsula to have three deacons serving our parish family.



Monday, August 10, we have extra reason to pray for them in the celebration of the feast of Saint Lawrence, deacon and martyr. For his dedication to service - especially to the poor - he is the patron saint of all deacons. Through his intercession, we pray for our deacons - and all those studying to be deacons in our archdiocese.

Each year we remember and celebrate the solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15. Because this year the date lands on a Saturday, it is not a day of obligation - but we celebrate our mother nonetheless!

By her immaculate conception and her union - heart to heart - with Her Son, Mary was untouched by either Original Sin or actual sin. As a result, she did not suffer the corruption of death, being assumed body & soul to Her Son's side. May we follow in Her footsteps!
