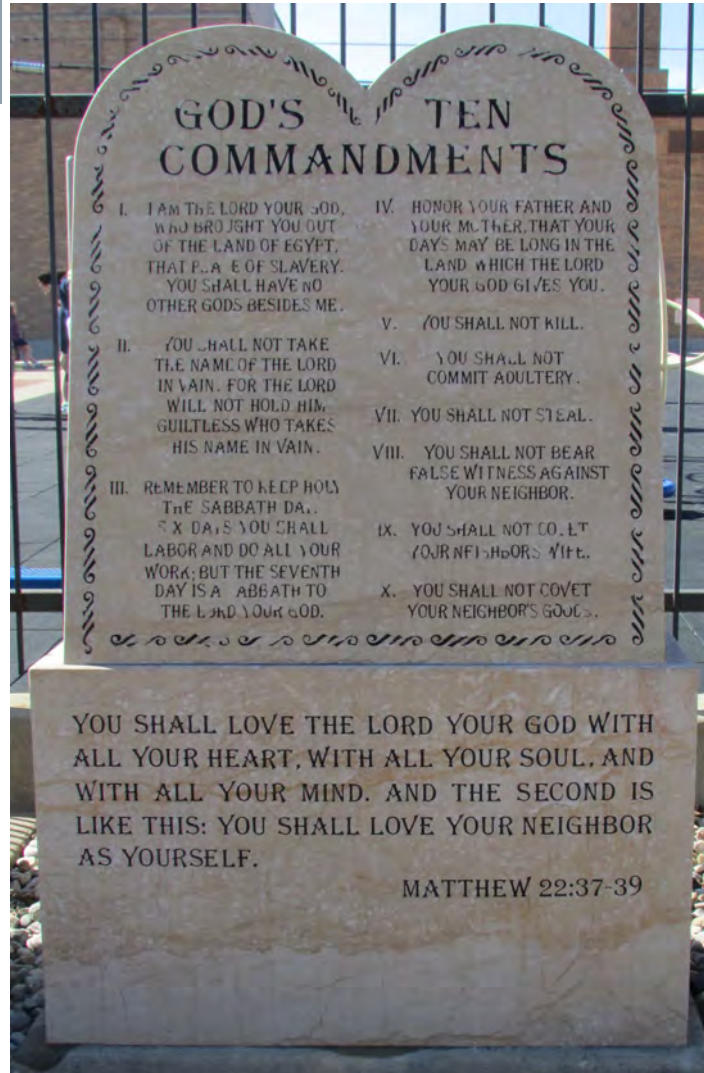

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Turn your eyes, O God, our shield; and look on the face of your anointed one;
one day within your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere.

Cf. Ps 84 (83): 10-11

In today's readings, the words of Paul in his
letter to the Romans - and later, those of the
Lord - seem cruel. Why does Paul want to
make those of his own race jealous? And why
does Jesus compare the desperate mother of a
tormented daughter with a dog?



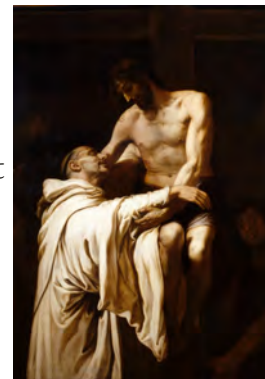
I propose that

'hide and seek' with their child: so that the
beloved will express his love for her, so that
the child will seek - and find! - her parents.
Jesus (and following His example, Paul after
Him) wants to elicit her faith, helping her to
realize its depth and strengthening it in the
course of having to make it known.

In today's collect (opening prayer) at Mass, we
asked God to "fill our hearts, we pray, with the
warmth of your love, so that, loving you in all
things and above all things, we may attain your
promises, which surpass every human desire."

How much do we love the Lord - and how do
we show that love in our daily life? May we
renew our prayer that God open our hearts to
receive His love.

"The Bridegroom's love, or
rather the love which is the
Bridegroom, asks in return
nothing but faithful love. Let
the beloved, then, love in
return. Should not a bride
love, and above all, Love's
bride? Could it be that Love
not be loved?



Rightly then does she give up all other feelings
and give herself wholly to love alone; in giving
love back, all she can do is to respond to
love."

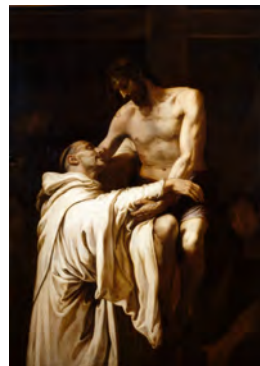
Yo propuso que la razón es el mismo de la mujer hacerse la difícil con su amado o que los padres juegan al
