WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

I am the salvation of the people, says the Lord. Should they cry to me in any distress, I will hear them, and I will be their Lord for ever.

"Seek the LORD while he may be found,
call him while he is near."

- Isaiah 55:6

How many of us are standing idle in our lives, as if we were those of today's parable, waiting for the Lord to say, 'You too come to me'? I do not think that they were sinning, but we - members of the Body of Christ, chosen of the Lord - we know well what we recited today in the responsorial psalm: The Lord is near to all who call on Him.



But... do we call on Him?

At times, yes! I propose that during much of our lives, we do not draw near to the Lord. Maybe we are afraid to presume to put

before Him our petitions or it does not even occur to us that we *could* put them before Him.

When we finally realize the generosity of the Lord, we, too, begin to grumble against Him - 'how come you didn't give us what *we* wanted?'. I imagine Him responding "did you not know that I am generous, that I always wait - and yet wait - for your invitation?"

"The LORD is near to all who call upon him, to all who call upon him in truth." Let us call upon Him today, even right now!

Monday, September 21, we celebrate the feast of Saint Matthew, apostle & evangelist.



Each of the evangelists have their own symbol and, in the case of Saint Matthew, his symbol is a winged man. Although these symbols are from the book of the prophet Ezekiel, the Church Fathers associated them with each gospel, as prefiguring the proclamation of the Lord. We also encounter them in the visions of Saint John in the book of Revelations.

The symbol of Saint Matthew is a winged man because his gospel begins with Christ's genealogy, focusing on His humanity.

After several days of vacation with friends in the woods, I will spend most of this week with parishioners from our parishes and throughout the archdiocese at the Palisades retreat center in Federal Way for the first of two trainings in advocacy for those who seek a declaration of nullity or, as they're more commonly called, an annulment.

There are SO many misconceptions about what the Church has to say about marriage, divorce, and annulments. While I can't do Her teachings justice here, I would offer this encouragement to anyone who has suffered from divorce and/or is in need of an annulment: **there is a path forward, with good people waiting to help you walk it!** Please call me or one of our priests to learn more.

¿Cuántos de nosotros estamos ociosos en nuestras vidas, como si fuéramos los de la parábola, esperando por el Señor decir 'vayan ustedes a mí'? No digo que ellos pecaron, pero nosotros - miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, elegidos de Dios - sabemos bien lo que decimos en el salmo responsorial: el Señor está cerca a todos que llama a Él.



Pero....¿la llamamos?

A veces, ¡sí! Propósito que, sobre mucho de nuestras vidas, no nos acercamos el Señor. Quisa tenemos miedo de presumir ante el

Señor con nuestras peticiones o no se nos ocurre que *podemos* ponerlos ante Él.

Cuando finalmente nos damos cuenta de la generosidad de Dios, comenzamos a reclamarle a Él - '¿porque no nos diste lo que quería?' Yo imagino que Él nos respondería "¿no sabías que soy generoso, que Yo siempre estaba - y aun ahora estoy - esperando por *su* invitación?"

"No está lejos de aquellos que lo buscan; muy cerca está el Señor, de quien lo invoca."
¡Que invoquémoslo hoy, ahora!

Encontremos también estos símbolos en las visiones de San Juan en el libro de Apocalipsis.

El símbolo de San Mateo es un hombre alado porque empieza su evangelio con la genealogía de Cristo, enfocado en la humanidad del Señor.
