WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

All that you have done to us, O Lord, you have done with true judgment, for we have sinned against you and not obeyed your commandments. But give glory to your name and deal with us according to the bounty of your mercy.

Cf. Dn 3: 31, 29, 30, 43, 42

"Which of the two did his father's will?"

Each time that I read this, I am heartened: by God's grace, I, too, can do the Father's will! But what is His will? The context of this parable is that Jesus is scolding - albeit gently - the priests and elders - that as they did with John the Baptist, so they were now rejecting His teaching... even as they saw themselves as being good sons of the Father.

We, too, face this temptation of considering ourselves faithful children even though we will



not accept the Lord as King of *all* of our life. We are content to follow some of Christ's teachings, but

there are parts of our lives, decisions, and hearts that we keep from Him - and fiercely!

We do well to remember the words of Jesus:

"If you wish to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to [the] poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." (Matthew 19:21). In a similar way, we must make a gift to the Lord of our lives - completely! Wuf.

Let us fearlessly cry out to the Lord: "help me!", that we may always choose His will, entrusting ourselves completely to Him.

On Tuesday, September 29, we celebrate the feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Revealed through their announcing God's message and guidance, we can read about them in both the Old and New Testaments.



Although most know the prayer to Saint Michael, there are also prayers to Saints Gabriel & Raphael - each having characteristics specific to their archangel. I invite you to look them up and pray them, especially as we celebrate their feast day!

On Saturday, October 3, we will have our first town hall meeting regarding the upcoming changes to our weekend Mass schedule. This one is offered specifically for the parishioners of Saint Mary Star of the Sea in Port Townsend - we will meet in the parish hall after the vigil Mass on Saturday.

¿POR QUÉ LOS CATÓLICOS HACEN ESO?

Cuanto has hecho con nosotros, Señor, es un castigo merecido, porque hemos pecado contra ti y no hemos obedecido tus mandamientos; pero da gloria a tu nombre y trátanos según tu gran misericordia.

"¿Cuál de los dos hizo la voluntad del padre?"

Cada vez que se lee este evangelio, yo recibo esperanza; ¡con razón puedo confiar que yo, también, puedo hacer la voluntad del Padre! ¿Y que es? El contexto de esta parábola es de Jesús castigando los sumos sacerdotes y los ancianos del pueblo - que no aceptaron las enseñanzas de San Juan el Bautista...y no iban a aceptar las de Jesús, aunque creyeran de sus mismos como si fueran hijos buenos del Padre.



Nosotros, también, tenemos esta tentación: de considerarnos como hijos fieles, aunque no

hemos aceptado el Señor como Rey de *todas* nuestras vidas. Estamos contentos seguir algunos de las enseñanzas de Cristo, pero hay partes de nuestras vidas, decisiones, y corazones que guardamos con fuerza.

Hacemos bien recordar las palabras de Jesús: "Si quieres ser perfecto, ve, vende todo lo que tienes, dalo a los pobres para que así tengas un tesoro en el cielo, luego ven y sígueme." (Mateo 19:21). De manera similar, hay que hacer al Señor un don de nuestra vida - en total. Ooof.

Pidamos a Dios: ¡ayúdanos!, que podemos elegir Su voluntad, confiándonos en Él.
