Dear friends,

Starting this month, I invite you to join me in prayer around upcoming changes across our parish family. After discussion with our administrative staff and parochial vicars, I have discerned the need for changes within our weekend Mass schedule, to be effective in the next few months.

The rationale for these changes comes from the priorities of long-term sustainability and pastoral presence - both for us priests currently serving as well as those who will someday follow us. Our current schedule not only requires that our priests spend minimal time with parishioners after Mass (save at one location) and has the priest serving in the central region not only rushing between locations but offering the maximum number of Masses into the mid-afternoon. As a result, we can not be meaningfully present and, in the central region, are exhausted each Sunday.

Here is what the new schedule will look like:

You can read a fuller breakdown on my website (www.fathermaurer.com), but here are the major benefits of this new schedule:

- **Saint Mary Star of the Sea** keeps its two Sunday Masses, with zero disruption to Sunday language-speaking offerings and maintaining its between-Masses programs. The priest does zero driving between Masses, and can be meaningfully present before and after every Mass.
- **Saint Joseph** gains a vigil Mass (with confessions beforehand) and at both the vigil and Sunday Masses (a different priest offering each), the priest can be present before and after.
- **Queen of Angels** maintains its Saturday schedule and the slightly earlier Sunday Mass allows the priest to spend meaningful time with parishioners after Mass before going to Saint Joseph.
- **Saint Anne & Saint Thomas** swap vigil Mass, with a time to be determined at St. Thomas to maximize availability and maintain the customary after-Mass potluck. Saint Anne has both of its Masses on the same day, with the Spanish & English-speaking communities easily able to interact with each other between Masses (both socially and, potentially, in all-parish faith formation programs), and the priest can spend meaningful time with parishioners after Mass.

With these changes come considerations yet to be decided. For example, when will Saint Mary Star of the Sea offer confessions to offset the move to Saint Joseph? What is the best time for a vigil Mass at Saint Joseph? What will be the best time for the vigil Mass at Saint Thomas the Apostle - especially given both distance and weather considerations? Of the two Sunday Masses at Saint Anne, which will be in English and which will be in Spanish?

Undoubtedly this raises concerns as well - though they all might be summed up in one: how will our communities make it through such changes?

Friends, this is where I most especially want to dwell in this letter: that our communities will not just survive change - intimidating though it is! - but will continue to **thrive**. Though there are challenges to nearly all these adjustments, they will further enable us to come together as fellow Catholics - not just priests with parishioners, but also each other within our communities. And truly, *this is the purpose of Partners in the Gospel!* As Archbishop Etienne remarked [in his pastoral letter kicking all of this off](#), "the status quo is no longer an option" - before he went on to remind us of the creativity that we are called to embrace in carrying out the Lord's work.

Over the last two years, we've seen how our communities have experienced blessings from things old and new. Whether it is in a new roof, new heat pumps (air conditioning!), expanded retreats & events, or new initiatives in faith formation & small groups - to name a few - every one of our churches, among both our English and Spanish speaking language groups, has experienced blessings. And we've met challenges - notably those of our own priests' health, but also the needs of a priest whose mother was dying beyond our parish family - with generosity and, I daresay, great success!



In the coming weeks, I will be hosting town hall gatherings across our parish family, where I look forward to talking through these changes more extensively, answering questions, and gathering your input- particularly in those areas needing further determination.

In the meantime, let us place ourselves in the hands of the Lord, praying for ourselves and each other. May the Lord continue to bless our communities and ministry, that we may carry out the good work He has entrusted to us.

Queridos amigos,

Empezando este mes, les invito unirse conmigo en oración sobre cambios en nuestra familia parroquial. Después de conversación con nuestras empleados y sacerdotes vicarios, he realizado la necesidad de cambios en el horario de misas dominicales, efectivo en los próximos meses.

Las razones para estos cambios vienen de la prioridad de sostenibilidad y presencia pastoral - por nosotros sacerdotes en el presente y los que nos seguirán en el future. Ahora, nuestro horario nos demanda que solamente pasa tiempo mínima con parroquianos después de misa (excepto en Santa María) y el sacerdote en la región central tiene que darse prisa entre locaciones y ofrecer el número máximo de misas bien entrada la tarde. El resultado es que nosotros sacer no podemos estar presente y - especialmente en el Region central - estamos bien cansado cada domingo.

Esto es el nuevo horario:

Se pueda leer más en mi sitio de web (www.fathermaurer.com), pero les presento algunos de los beneficios aquí:

- **Santa María estrella del mar** mantenga sus misas dominicales y sus programas entre las misas. El sacer no tiene que manejar entre misas y pueda estar presente antes y después de cada misa.

- **San José** gana una misa de vigilia (con confesiones anteriormente) y en la y la misa dominical (con un sacerdote diferente ofreciendo cada una), el sacerdote pueda estar presente sin darse prisa en irse después.

- **Reina de los ángeles** mantenga sus horario los sábados y, con una misa dominical más temprano, permite que el sacerdote pueda estar presente después de la misa sin darse prisa en irse.

- **Santa Ana y San Tomás** cambian misas de vigilia (el tiempo de la misa en San Tomás será determinado, con consideración de distancias de manejar y la preservación de la comida compartida después de misa). Santa Ana tendría sus misas en la misma día, con los dos comunidades (inglés e hispana) recién capaces de interactuar entre misa (socialmente y en programas de formación sacramental) y el sacerdote pueda estar presente antes y después de cada misa. Estos cambios traigan otras consideraciones aún por decidir. Por ejemplo, ¿cuando tendremos confesiones en Santa Maria sin teniéndolos en sábado? ¿Cuándo será el tiempo mejor para la misa de vigilia en San José? ¿Cuándo será el tiempo mejor para la misa de vigilia en San Tomás - particularmente considerando complicaciones de distancia y el clima? ¿Entre las dos misas dominicales en Santa Ana, cuáles será en español y cual será en inglés?

También serán ansiedades en nuestras corazones - que podemos decir en solamente una pregunta: ¿cómo nuestras comunidades van a superar todo esto?

Amigos, esto es el punto que quiero hacer con el mayor énfasis: nuestras comunidades no solamente sobrevivirán estos cambios - ¡largos que son! - pero continuará prosperar. Si, hay los desafíos en estos cambios, nos ayudó unirnos - sacerdotes con parroquianos y también parroquianos con parroquianos. Verdaderamente, ¡esto es la razón de *Compañeros en el Evangelio*! Como el arzobispo Etienne dijo [en su carta pastoral](#), "El *status quo* ya no es una opción" - y nos exhortó de enfrentar el cambio con fe, valor e imaginación.

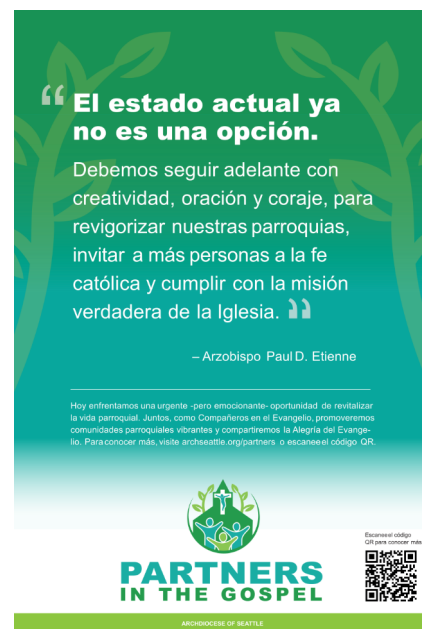
En los dos años, hemos visto como nuestras comunidades han experimentado bendiciones en maneras familiares y nuevos. En un techo nuevo, nuevas bombas de calor (¡aire acondicionado!), más retiros y eventos, los iniciativas nuevos en formación de fe y grupos de estudio - para nombrar algunos - en cada una de nuestras iglesias, ofrecido en inglés y español, ¡habían bendecido mucho! Y hemos enfrentado desafíos - notablemente de la salud de nuestros sacerdotes, pero también de la necesidad de un sacerdote aparte de nuestra familia parroquial quienes madre era muriendo - con generosidad y, yo digo, ¡con gran éxito!

En algunas semanas, ofreceré reuniones de ayuntamiento en nuestra familia parroquial, en que anticipo hablando con más detalle estos cambios, contestando preguntas, y recibiendo sus pensamientos - especialmente en las áreas que necesita más información.

Mientras tanto, que nos pongamos en las manos del Señor, orando uno por otro. Que Dios continúe bendecir nuestras comunidades y ministro, que perseveremos en la obra buena que Él nos ha encomendado.
